If, in the opinion of the Golf Course Superintendent, the golf course is too wet or subject to damage as to disallow all cars, then the physically handicapped player shall also obey the golf car path-only rule or refrain from play." Tripp's Tips:

Turfgrass: Now that turfgrass growth has begun to slow down, you can finally decrease your mowing frequency. Warm season turfgrasses will not require the one inch of water per week to stay healthy. You may even want to turn the irrigation system completely off for the next few months. If you are overseeding this winter disregard the prior statement. If you have not begun working on overseeding your lawn you will need to start. The first two weeks in October are the last two weeks you have for the overseeding process. Remember before the process begins remove all tree leaves from the turf area to insure proper coverage. Apply the seed according to the directions on the bag's label. Increase the watering regime to an inch and a quarter per week to insure germination of the ryegrass. When the lawn becomes established, water only when necessary to prevent the ryegrass from wilting. Fertilize ryegrass after the second mowing. Use a complete fertilizer such as 16-4-8. Fertilize with 1 pound of nitrogen per 1,000 square feet.

Annals and Bedding Plants: Fertilizing perennials is not needed at this time of year. Allow perennials to go dormant so they can tolerate the winter weather. If you have not added mulch to perennials now is the time to do so. Mulch at a 2-inch depth. This will help conserve soil moisture and protect the root system from the winter weather. Keep new plantings as well as established gardens watered if the weather is dry. Prune perennials when their tops are nipped by the cold. Also, clean up the dead leaves from around perennials. If left on the ground, leaves can harbor disease and provide insects a place to overwinter. Your pansies, violas, kale, and ornamental cabbage should be in the ground. Remember annuals should be planted allowing at least six weeks before first expected freeze to help them get established. Keep an eye on the water needs of annuals. Check the soil for moisture; don't wait until the plants show wilting to start watering. Use a complete fertilizer such as 10-10-10 if the plants have begun to grow. This will encourage establishment and flowering.

Trees and Shrubs: Don't let cooler temperatures deceive you. Continue to water on a regular basis. Prune any branches that are dead, diseased, or broken. Keep a watchful eye out for spider mites, whiteflies, and bag worms. Apply insecticides such as Sevin, Dursban, or Orthene to prevent damage from aphids and spider mites. Inspect Arborvitae and Juniper for small cone-shaped bags. They resemble a hornets nest but much smaller. The nests are about the size of a half dollar. The only control is to inspect and remove all the bags you find. If there is any evidence of Scale on shrubs, spray with Dormant Oil in late fall and again in early spring. Do not fertilize trees or shrubs. Now and next month are excellent times to plant trees and shrubs. New plantings can range from now until mid December. Remember to make the planting hole only as deep as the rootball but, make it at least two to three times the diameter of the rootball.

Per our normal schedule, greens coloring procedures will be determined by existing color and weather conditions.

This winter we will be working a lot in our natural areas, limbing and removing select trees in house. There will also be additional removal of exposed tree roots as we have done in past off seasons.

Our staff would like to wish everyone a Happy Thanksgiving as we look toward our winter season.

CYCLING ... Indoor cycling is the most popular cardio class in the fitness industry today. The instructor will coach you through all sorts of terrain to help you burn the most calories in the least amount of time! (45 minutes)

STEP & SCULPT ... Combining the cardio of step with the muscle strengthening of sculpt, and topped off with some necessary stretching. (60 min)

POWER YOGA ... Take the traditional poses of Yoga that you already know and turn them into a fat burning series of moves and you're talking about an awesome cardio and strength workout. The last 15 minutes of class is devoted to traditional Yoga stretching. (Some previous Yoga experience is preferred.)

MUSCLE CONFUSION ... Get your heart pumping in a variety of ways while sculpting your entire body. Using weights, tubes, medicine balls, and gliding disks, your muscles will be challenged and strengthened.

SATURDAY CHALLENGE ... 8:30-10:00am. Rodd, Jennifer and Bethany will team teach this class designed especially for those participating in the Fitness Challenge. Come prepared to work hard ...
